## SPTWD - EDIFY NORTHEAST INDIA PROJECT REPORT

PERIOD: APRIL 2018 – MARCH 2019

### INTRODUCTION

EDIFY NE INDIA was launched in September 2016 as pilot project in partnership with SPTWD and later named 'SPTWD-EDIFY NE INDIA PROJECT'. The project supports community based low fees independent Private Christian School in Kangpokpi, Chandel, Churachandpur districts and few school in Imphal area. The current activities include Leadership and Teachers Transformation Training, along with Institution of Discipleship Club in selected school and survey to identify private schools in the target districts deeper and wider.

During the reporting period April 2018 – March 2019, the project team has accomplished following activities/programs shown in the table below, in an endeavor to change and transform more than 80 schools in the rural areas of Manipur.

#### OTHER HAPPENINGS:

**Staff Training/Conference:** Mr. Thangboi Haokip (CTTO) attended **Culture, Ethnicity & Diversity workshop** from 23 -27 April 2018 at Donbosco, Guwhati. The workshop was organized by DAI India and Dr. Paul from US, the resource person.

Mr. Thangboi also attended in the second Workshop on HimLead on 28-30 Sept-2018. The Content Include-Relational Leadership, focusinf on who they are and what they are like, Leadership types, leader's use of Power (Authority), Integrity and Accountability.

**EDIFY HQ Support Visits:** Dr. Jonathan Mitchel, Asia Director visited India from 20-31 May 2018. He met ESAF team our new MFI partner in Kerala. We had discussion and planning together and also conducted one day consultation meeting with ESAF & EDIFY partner schools in Manipur on 30 May 2018. We also met with Adhyayan team in Delhi in regards to their school assessment programs and also with Change Alliance team regarding legal structures for Edify NE India.

**CTTO Conference:** Mr. Sem Haokip attended CTTOs conference in Lima from 3-12 June 2018. We all appreciate Wondim Makonen vision and leadership for transformation initiatives through CTTOs. In particular Dr. Paula's presentation on EDIFY Model education; sharing and learning from each CTTOs; school visits and overall sharing and interaction amongst and with resource persons was very good. It was also great to have Elder Luis, Tiger and Carol and Vanessa and other program directors from Latin America.

**School Survey:** Since May 2018, Mr. Devbarta is engaged as part-time consultant to conduct School Survey in Chandel, Churachandpur and Kangpokpi districts. The idea is to establish relationship with the schools before inviting them to Edify school and teachers training programs. The work is in progress. The final report will include list of all private schools in the three districts.

**School visits:** Mr. Thangboi and Mr. Sem continue with the school visits regularly and help Youth Transformation Club and introduced Cultivating Character to be used in Youth Transformation Club in Edify partner schools during the reporting period. Mr. Thangboi also participated in Value Education program in two schools with additional one-day orientation to the teachers.

**Networking:** We have established working relationship with Dr. David Dass – National Director for India for Character Solutions International. We have also contacted Henry Martin Institute, Hyderabad (one of the states in South India) for transformation leadership and teachers training. Mr. Sem have visited them in July to explore opportunities to work and partner with them. Besides, we also have established New Life Crusader (NLC) for conducting Value Education in Edify partner school which can come alongside transformation of the students in various Edify Partner school.

**EDIFY GLOBAL CONFERENCE AND CTTO MEETING, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC:** Mr. Sem and Mr. Thangboi travel to Dominican Republic (Santo Domingo) for Edify Global Conference and CTTO meeting. The conference lasted from 21-27 January 2019. The CTTO meeting lasted from 28-30 January 2019. It was a enlightening to join in the conference, hearing reports from other countries namely African, Latin American Countries and North East India. We also had privilege to report Edify NE-India as well. Each department of Edify such as Senior management team, Finance Department, Assessment team etc. also have presented their works during the conference. The CEO Edify also have presented the History, present and future ministry of the Edify. After the global

conference all the CTOs of different Countries meet for another three days for discussion and presentations. The discussion was all about Transformation of individual and schools that Edify work.

**HIMLEAD TRAINING-** Mr. Thangboi attended HIMLEAD TRAINING-3 from 4-6 February 2019 at Bethel Prayer Centre- Barapani, Meghalaya, after DR Conference. The workshop/training was organized by Elim Resource Center, Guwahati. The Resource persons were Rev. Gibson, Pastor Senti, and Mr. Ashim.

**School visits:** (Moreh) Mr. Thangboi and Mr. Sem continue with the school visits regularly to support the school leaders and teachers. Mr. Thangboi also have visited Private low Budget Schools in Moreh Town. He visited about 7 Schools and have consulted with them individually. It is a voice from parents from Moreh schools, expressing their woes of Moreh being drug Centre, which need good attention from other organization to help students. The town Moreh is an International border between India and Myanmar, where drugs are transported from South East Asian Countries.

There are 10+ schools in the town of Moreh including Government and Catholic run schools. The visited schools were: Agape English School, Bethsaida Academy, Bethel High School, Bright-way Academy, Mt. Moreh Public School, The Salvation Army-Hermon Junior High School and Maranatha Kingdom School.

**School visits:** (Imphal Valley): Edify has been working in three districts of Manipur and few schools in Imphal area. About 15+ schools have been visited in the month of February 2019. We have visited schools, collecting their data. The school which we visited are: St. Peter School, Assemblies of God, Brighter Shepherded Acadmy, The little Angels School, Grace Academy, Residential Kids School, Seventh Day Adventist, Standard English School, Mario Montessori School, St. John English School, Baby Seikam School, Church of God Ecclesia English School, DM Memorial English School, and Grace Academy (Potsangbam). We have visited the good numbers of schools in Imphal area.

**EDIFY INDIA COUNTRY PRESENTATION:** Mr. Sem and Mr. Thangboi worked so hard, collecting information from the schools to present in Edify, globally. The power point presentation was prepared and shared to Edify Country presentation on 17.10.2018. The updated country presentation was also shared to Edify.

**ONLINE COUNTRY PRESENTATION:** Mr. Sem and Mr. Thangboi use to join Global Conference Call once a month for Country updates and discussion for about one and half hours and online call on every Monday evening, which the Edify staffs are expected to join without fail.

**ORIENTATION OF SISY-Admin cum Accountant:** Newly joined Admin cum Accountant Ms. Sisy was given Orientation about handling files and documentation by Mr. Tongkhomang Haokip, Managing Director SPTWD. During the orientation the Mr. Tongkhomang gave lessons on Account Management and Administration, the guideline for transection by cash, cheque etc. amount more than Rs. 5000/- should not be given by cash but by NEFT and Cheque.

**JONATHAN MITCHELL AND MAKONEN GETU VISIT TO EDIFY- NE-INDIA:** It was on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018 Mr. Jonathan and Makonen visited Manipur to strengthen the project. During their stayed in EDIFY NE-INDIA the following things were discussed:



1. **11.12.2018** Meeting with EDIFY NE-INDIA staffs meeting held in the office. During the meeting Mr. Sem and Mr. Thangboi reported the work done so far to 52 schools from three districts of Manipur and presented the upcoming programs which will be conducted in three different districts.
2. **12.12.2018**: Meeting with Evangelical Social Forum (ESAF) at PIZZA House Near Airport: The meeting with ESAF and EDIFY at PIZZA House was about LOAN disbursement to EDIFY partner schools in Manipur. The outcome of the meeting was to find out two loyal and two assessors to look after the documents of the school who look forward of getting loan from ESAF. The Edify Staffs would invite ESAF and have meeting with the loyal after finding them to discuss about the document matters.
3. **13.12.2018**- School visit to Saikul: The team from EDIFY reached "Diamond Sower Academy"-Saikul. DAS welcome and attended the team from EDIFY. The program begins with short speech for welcoming note and prayer from Pastor Thangboi. Sem introduce all the school owners and narrate the story how Edify entered into India special reference to North east India. After which all the proprietors were given to reflect the joy, hardship and challenges from them. The schools were Lotong Memorial School, LL. Henjou English School, Christian English High School, LM School, SNG School, VM Nazareth English School, and Diamond Sower Academy.

**BANDH & STRIKE:** Due to Bandh and Strikes in Manipur we find difficulties to carry out some certain program and activities to Edify Partner schools.
